## Parent Governor Places Available

There are now 2 available seats on the Governing Body of Hunmanby Primary School. Being a Governor is a really important role and can be a very rewarding one. Our Governing Body is made up of the Headteacher, The Chair of Governors, one Teacher Governor, 3 Parent Governors and 5 Co-opted Governors. As a result of their children leaving the school, we now have two places for the role of Parent Governor available. The Governing Body meets 3 times each term under the areas of Pupil Support, Finance and Resources and Standards (academic results/tracking etc). All Governors are provided with opportunities to get training to support areas they may be unfamiliar with (such as finance). As a Parent Governor, the only qualifications you will need will be to a parent and have a real desire to move our good school forward to aim for even better outcomes for our children.

You will be welcome to come in and have an informal chat and coffee/tea with me to talk about it in more detail. If there are more than 2 interested parents, then we would have to go through an election process.
