## Ofsted Inspection



We are very proud that our outcome was very 'Good'. Our Ofsted Inspection took place on Tuesday 6<sup>th</sup> November. It was a one day inspection called a Section 8 Inspection and had one Lead Inspector. The inspection looked at the *Overall Effectiveness of the School*, the *Effectiveness of Leadership and Management*, *Teaching, Learning and Assessment*, *Personal Development, Behaviour and Welfare of the*

*Children*, the *Outcomes for The Pupils* and the *Quality, Standards and Effectiveness of Early Years Provision*. Another key area for inspection is the *Effectiveness of Safeguarding in the school*. We were judged Good in all of these areas. This means that we will be inspected again in 4 years time and will hopefully have built on the recommendations in the report.
