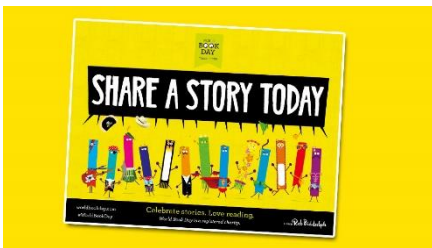

Share A Book With Your Child

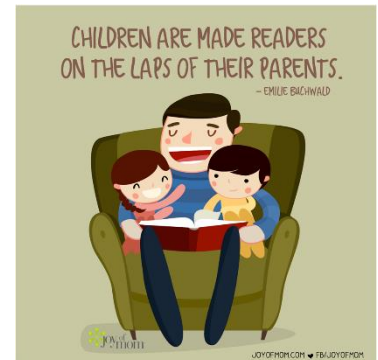
We would also like to invite all parents in to share a book and a biscuit with their child. We have allocated a 20 minute time slot for each year group, please see timings below:
