Parents Questionnaire

We value your opinions, so I was particularly pleased to get nearly 70 responses back from parents. The results are at the back of this newsletter. They show overwhelmingly that we are getting it right with nearly all the responses saying that they Strongly Agree/Agree with the statements. We are going to have a closer look at our anti-bullying Policy next academic year to make sure that we are not complacent and

that we can improve systems for dealing with any incidents in the school. We will also look at systems of communication with parents, to see if the Newsletter in its current form is appropriate or a more digital approach should be adopted.

The school gate on Priest Close was mentioned as a safeguarding concern. I would like to reassure parents that we have a robust risk assessment in place for the gate which is left unlocked after 9.00am to allow deliveries etc. to get into school. The gates on either side are padlocked and all of the classroom doors are secure, the only way into school is through the Reception. We have signage on the gate encouraging parents/visitors to help us to safeguard by ensuring that they shut the gate when leaving after 9.00am. Our procedures have been ratified by the Local Authority Health and Safety Officer and the Police and are compliant with Ofsted.
