The Big Buzz

Our Big Buzz continues on Wednesday afternoons which involves the children from Year 1 to Year 6 and allows us to promote key values and skills in PSHE (Personal, Social, Health and Economic) education as well as aspects of the SMSC (Spiritual, Moral, Social and Cultural) agenda that schools in Britain should be promoting.

Your child will be in a group of either mixed Year 1 to Year 3 or Year 4 to Year 6 children and will carry out a different activity each week designed to promote our '**Magnificent Seven**'. These are values and skills that we want the children of Hunmanby Primary School to have, in order to become a rounded individual and a valued member of society. They are: **Risk** (understanding risk and taking risks), **Independence** (having initiative/responsibility), **Aspiration** (ambition to achieve), **Teamwork** (leadership/honesty/loyalty/integrity/fairness), **Speaking and Listening** (negotiating/influencing), **Resilience** (not giving up/bravery/self-control) and **Understanding** (tolerance/forgiveness/empathy/caring).

Each half-term there will be a different theme to develop the Magnificent Seven (see below) and this half-term we are focusing on '**Keeping Safe**'. We know the children and teachers love it, and Ofsted could really see the value and importance too.

This takes place in school on Tuesday 5th February and the theme this year is '*Together For A Better Internet*'.

In the UK the Safer Internet Day campaign will particularly empower young people to take control of their digital lives and consider how consent works in an online context. It explores how young people ask for, give and receive consent

online. This could be in their friendships or relationships, how they take and share images and videos or how they manage their privacy and data. We will have a whole school assembly and the teachers will be using age appropriate resources in class.

Leave Of Absence During Term Time

Can I remind parents that the Department for Education's stance on holidays in term time remains unchanged and that they will, through the Local Authority, enforce a fixed penalty for 10 or more unauthorized sessions (5 days) at school unless it has been authorized by myself as 'exceptional circumstances'. Dogs In School

If you walk your dog to school when dropping off your child please make sure that it is under control and tethered away from the school entrance. If you do leave your dog, you must be aware that it is your responsibility. It should also be mentioned that it is North Yorkshire Policy that no dogs are allowed onto the school premises for obvious reasons. The only exceptions are Guide dogs or dogs with appropriate risk assessments such as the Dogs In School charity which we have been involved with in the past.



Cycling To School and Scooters

Can I remind parents of children wishing to bring bikes and scooters into school that they must complete a Cycling to School Request Form if they haven't already done so. You can get a form from me or at the office. Carefully read the conditions outlined on the form and return the completed request forms to me. I am happy for a child to come to school on a scooter provided that they walk the scooters when inside the school grounds. Please note that we only allow children in Year 3, 4, 5 and 6 to bring bikes and scooters to school.
